A strategy session, focusing on upcoming priorities and objectives, will follow soon after.

trade, and student of international trade. We are hoping to do more in-person networking and educational seminars. We are ready to go. Keep an eye on our events calendar for any upcoming events.

The Global Supply Chain Grinch that could Steal Christmas


